






# Pediatric Transplant COLORING CONTEST

CORE and UPMC Children's Hospital announce our **2022 National Donate Life Month Coloring Contest** to help raise awareness about organ, tissue and cornea donation. Pediatric transplant patients and their families are invited to share their creative gifts by designing an original poster with a positive message about organ donation.

## Step 2: Show Us Your Masterpiece

Be sure to include child's name and age, what type of transplant they've received or are waiting for, plus a parent or guardian's street address, phone number, and e-mail address so that winners may be notified.

## RULES & CONDITIONS


- Contest is open to children ages 18 and under; void where prohibited.

- Entries must be original.
- No copyrighted artwork will be accepted with the exception of the coloring page options included in this booklet.
- Entries must be at least 8.5x11" and no larger than 18x24".
- Materials that can be used include crayon, marker, paint, pencil, charcoal and pastels.
- Winners will be selected by a panel of judges based on criteria of originality, artistic merit, and effective use of theme.
- By entering the contest, artists and their guardians are declaring their artwork to be original, acknowledge that the artwork becomes the property of CORE and cannot be returned, and permit the artwork to be shown and reproduced.
